Ultrasound Consent Form

We are performing an abdominal ultrasound on your pet today. In order to get a proper image, your pet will be administered a sedative to keep him/her calm during this procedure. Sedation usually lasts only a few hours, but some patients are more sensitive and can remain quiet until the following day. Rarely, depending on the type of sedation used, there may be a detrimental impact on blood pressure, heart rate, or breathing that could require intervention or risk serious health complications.

The area of my pet's ultrasound will be shaved in order to allow adequate imaging. Minor irritation may occur to the skin as a consequence. Hair regrowth generally takes multiple weeks to occur, but can be more prolonged in certain pets.

- I consent to have an ultrasound performed on my pet and a guided aspirate if indicated.
- I consent to the administration of sedation to my pet, if necessary. I understand that sedation will be administered by my regular veterinarian
